Growth Questions for 8/29 – 9/5

1. What insight, principle, or observation from this weekend's message did you find most helpful, eye-opening, troubling?
2. What do you see as the most beneficial aspect of being involved in a community/small group?
3. Share a personal experience of being involved in a group. It can be from any area of life; community, neighborhood, social, educational, religious. What aspects were positive? Negative? Memorable? Worth replicating?
4. Is there a level of risk associated with being involved with other people on a group level? Do 'strangers' or 'outsiders' find it easy to become a part of the group? How would an outsider best be folded into a group?
5. What are the costs associated with starting a group? Are there relational costs? Financial? Time?

Living on Mission***

1. Consider your level of personal involvement in a group. Luke 24 teaches that life with Jesus and others is more manageable. How could your life benefit from becoming a part of a small group? How could others benefit from your involvement?
2. Scripture, hospitality, community, relationship, and truth all have a place in the 'groups' at C@M. How will you ensure that your life and your role foster those core elements?
3. Luke 24 teaches that while walking the paths of life we should include believers, Jesus, and non-believers. Can you do this alone? If not, what steps do you need to take to be a part of a group at C@M? Host? Lead? Facilitate? Participate?
4. Return on an investment may not show up for many years. A willingness to invest deeply now is linked directly to the payoff in the future. Who are you walking the Emmaus road with?
